

Virginia Swimming Hall of Fame 2020 Nomination Information

Nominee Qualifications

A. Athlete

- 1) was a registered athlete in Virginia Swimming
- 2) achieved one or more of the following:
 - US Olympic team member
 - US National team member at World Champs
 - World record holder
 - US record holder
 - Paralympic Games medalist or team member
 - National Age Group record holder (11 and Over age groups)

B. Coach

- 1) coached swimming for 20 or more years and
- 2) coached in Virginia Swimming for 10 or more years and
- 3) coached Virginia swimmers who were on the US National team and
- 4) coached at least two Top 16 swimmers and Virginia recorder holders

C. Official

- 1) served as a Virginia Swimming official for 15 or more years and
- 2) had significant positive impact on officiating in Virginia Swimming

D. Volunteer

- 1) was a non-athlete member of Virginia Swimming for 10 or more years and
- 2) made significant positive contributions to the operations of Virginia Swimming

Qualified deceased candidates are eligible for nomination.

Nominating Procedure

Nominations for the Hall of Fame must be made by two (2) current members of Virginia Swimming by filling out and submitting the online nomination form. The nomination form should include a description of the nominee's outstanding achievements and/or contributions. The form can be completed online by first saving the document to your computer then filling it out and saving it again.

Nominations for 2020 must be submitted to the Selection Committee by **August 1, 2020**.
