	Age on 03/04/2020 (first day of the meet) will determine age for the entire meet.		
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.		
	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.		
FORMAT:	All events will be timed finals.		
	Each swimmer needs to provide his own timer for everyone of his events.		
WARM-UP:	Warm-ups will start at 4:30pm competition starts at 5:00pm.

	Teams submit entries via email, or on deck at least 30 minutes prior to the meet start time		
	A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries.		
	"No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. All entry times must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.		
	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 3 individual event(s)		
	Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.

	Deck entries will be accepted in the order received for all swimmers, to the extent that time permitting. Deck entries must be submitted to the Clerk-of-Course on the provided forms.

AWARDS:	No awards will be provided.			
PENALTIES:	A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as			
	 Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times. 			
	 Athlete competed in the incorrect age group. 			
	Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet.			
	If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.			
RULES:	 Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded. The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection 			
ROLLO.	Policy will govern this meet.			
	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.			
	Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.			
	Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.			
	In accordance with VSI best practices, all swimmers should shower before entering the pool.			
	In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
