FORMAT:	All 12 & under swimmers will swim in the Friday evening session.							
	All 13 & over swimmers will swim in the Saturday morning session.							
	All events will be timed finals.							
WARM-UP:	Friday's 12 & under session: Warm-ups at 5:00pm: Competition starts at 6:00pm.							
	Saturday's 13 & over session: Warm-ups at 6:30am; competition starts at 7:30am.							
ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS Friday, July 24, 2020							
	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 individual event(s).							
	Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.							
	No deck entries will be accepted.							
FEES:	Individual events: \$2.00 per event Swimmer surcharge: \$2.50 per person (entered in the meet in any capacity)							
SEEDING:	Swimmers will be sent to the blocks by a volunteer standing outside the pool doors.							
	Events and heats will be announced via audio speaker in the parking lot.							
	All events will be pre-seeded.							
AWARDS:	Heat winner ribbons will be awarded for 12 & under events at this meet.							
PENALTIES:	A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as							
	 Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times. 							
	Athlete competed in the incorrect age group.							
	 Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet. 							
	If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.							
RULES:	 Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded. Athletes must arrive in their suits. Locker rooms will not be available for changing. 							
NOLLS.								
	All individuals entering the facility will be expected to answer Virginia Department of Health screening questions to include temperature screening.							
	Coaches, officials, and spectators must wear masks.							
	 The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy will govern this meet. 							
	 All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. 							
	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.							
	Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.							
	Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.							
	Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.							
	 An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization

	signed by a licensed healthcare provider.							
	In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

2020 LY INTRASQUAD MEET

PLANS AND PROCEDURES

- ALL CURRENT STATE AND LOCAL REGULATIONS WILL BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO. MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED OF ALL OFFICIALS, VOLUNTEERS, AND COACHES WHO ARE ON DECK. MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED OF ALL SPECTATORS WHO WISH TO ENTER THE POOL AREA TO WATCH THEIR SWIMMERS.
- STATE GUIDELINES CAN BE FOUND HERE.
- ALL SWIMMERS AND SPECTATORS WILL SIT OUTDOORS IN THE BLOCKED-OFF SIDE PARKING LOT OF THE JAMERSON YMCA.
- SWIMMERS WILL ENTER THE BUILDING ONLY THROUGH THE SIDE DOORS NEAR THE STARTING BLOCKS, ONE HEAT BEFORE THEY ARE TO SWIM. SWIMMERS WILL EXIT THE WATER AND IMMEDIATELY EXIT THE POOL AREA TO THE OUTSIDE PARKING LOT.
- SPECTATORS MAY ENTER THE POOL AREA VIA SIDE DOORS AT THE SCOREBOARD END OF THE POOL TO WATCH THEIR SWIMMER'S RACE AND ARE ASKED TO THEN RETURN OUTSIDE AFTER THE RACE. THERE WILL BE NO SEATING ON DECK. SPECTATORS MAY ENTER THE POOL AREA ONLY FOR THEIR SWIMMER'S HEAT.
- COACHES AND OFFICIALS WILL ENTER THE POOL AREA THROUGH THE SIDE DOOR AT EITHER END OF THE POOL.
- SWIMMERS AND SPECTATORS ARE ENCOURAGED TO BRING POP-UP TENTS OR OTHER APPROPRIATE SHELTER FOR THEIR OUTDOOR AREA.
- SWIMMERS AND SPECTATORS NEED TO MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING PROTOCOLS WHILE IN THE OUTDOOR STAGING AREA.
- DURING THE MEET, THERE WILL BE NO MORE THAN 16 OFFICIALS/VOLUNTEERS, 8 COACHES, 8 SWIMMERS IN THE WATER, 8 SWIMMERS STANDING BEHIND THE BLOCKS, AND 8 SPECTATORS.
- In applying for this sanction, Lynchburg YMCA agrees to comply and to enforce all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Virginia Swimming, the Commonwealth of Virginia, and Campbell County.
